

Lost Trail Lodge

I-80 to Donner Pass Road Exit 184
 Mile Marker 3.9 Coldstream Road
 530-320-9268

*If the gate is locked, access the canyon through the main park entrance, just West of Coldstream Rd on Donner Pass Rd. Tell the folks at the kiosk you're a guest and you'll avoid the Day Use Fee.




SUMMER PARKING
 1/2 mile to the lodge
 Park at least 200' away from the RR tracks.

Green trail: main road
 Purple trail: alternate route
 Brown trails: won't get you there
 Blue: creeks
 *DO NOT attempt to walk through the tunnel!

The trail is NOT well marked. Get an early start. Do not come in during the night; you might get lost. The Innkeeper cannot help you if you get lost on the trail.

This map was not created with GPS accuracy and is intended to only give the user a general idea of the layout of Coldstream Canyon. It is not to scale. The recommended routes on this map may be dangerous and even deadly depending on many variables such as current avalanche danger, weather, snow pack depth, skill and experience level, and time of day. If you are not an expert and experienced backcountry hiker, climber, skier, snowboarder, or snow-shoer, we highly recommend you hire a professional guide to take you into the backcountry.  Park on the EAST side, as close to the grey lock box as possible. DO NOT park on the roadway- you may be towed.
